RESOLUTIONS

The following Resolution was adopted by City Council on March 9, 2009.

09-R-17 AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF CITY FUNDS FOR THE HILLIARD YOUTH AND FAMILY COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, Chapter 149 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Hilliard provides for the establishment of Boards and Commissions; and

WHEREAS, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HILLIARD ESTABLISHED THE YOUTH AND FAMILY COMMISSION ("COMMISSION") BY ORDINANCE NO. 01-13 ON APRIL 9, 2001; AND

WHEREAS, the mission of the Commission is to facilitate youth development by empowering youth and adults to build assets and provide opportunities that enhance the quality of life; and

WHEREAS, the Commission relies solely on donations, grants and fundraisers to operate; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Hilliard believes it is in the best interest of the city's youth and adults to assist the Commission in its funding efforts; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the Council of the City of Hilliard that providing funding to the Commission in the amount of \$15,650.00 should be allowed, subject to quarterly reporting by the Commission to Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hilliard, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The Council of the City of Hilliard hereby determines that providing funding to the Hilliard Youth and Family Commission is in the best interest of the city's youth and adults to facilitate youth development by empowering youth and adults to build assets and provide opportunities that enhance the quality of life, and that an expenditure in the amount of \$15,650.00 is hereby authorized, subject to quarterly reporting by the Commission to Council on the use of the funds by the Commission.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is effective upon its adoption.

POSTPONED LEGISLATION

08-56 CREATING A STORMWATER MANAGEMENT UTILITY; ESTABLISHING AN INITIAL STORMWATER MANAGEMENT SERVICE CHARGE TO BE PAID BY USERS BASED ON AN EQUIVALENT RESIDENTIAL UNIT (ERU); CREATING A SPECIAL FUND FOR THE DEPOSIT AND USE OF ALL SERVICE CHARGES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO CONTRACT WITH A CONSULTANT TO CONDUCT AN IMPERVIOUS AREA STUDY TO DETERMINE THE ON-GOING STORMWATER MANAGEMENT SERVICE CHARGE PER ERU; AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO PAY CERTAIN COSTS OF THE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT UTILITY. *Note: Postponed at second reading/public hearing on 10/27/2008 to the date certain of 04/13/2009.*
