JUNE 28-JULY 2 • Adventure and Sports! Activity Number: 313535-02

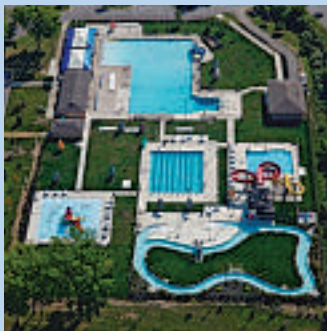
